

Parent/Guardian Consent for Virtual Reality at HHPL

The Library uses Virtual Reality equipment to engage participants in programs and to encourage them to discover new technology. We use these devices to explore, learn, create and play in a three-dimensional, computer-generated world. Program participants will be within a supervised environment and will not engage with any online gaming communities, create accounts, or use personal information.

Program participants using the HTC Vive Virtual Reality technology must be at least 10 years old, and participants between the ages of 10 and 12 will require consent (below) of a parent or guardian at the time of play. Also, participants should have no pre-existing physical or mental health conditions. After the virtual reality activity, participants may experience temporary dizziness, lightheadedness, drowsiness, disorientation, and/or impaired balance or coordination.
